DNB publishes Update BSI Taxonomy 2.0.2

At the beginning of October 2021, DNB published a new Balance Sheet Items (BSI) taxonomy: version 2.0.2. Compared to version 2.0.1, version 2.0.2 has fixed an error in the country list reference for forms 9013 and 9017. The taxonomy and the manual include the last definitive extensions as a result of the update of the European regulation.

On the BSI webpage of the Digital Reporting Portal you will find:

- The entire taxonomy package, including release notes
- An Excel file with hatched details, what the changes are from version 2.0.2 compared to the previous version 2.0.1, the test version 2.0.0 and the current version 1.0.2. Compared to version 2.0.1, version 2.0.2 has fixed an error in the country list reference for forms 9013 and 9017
- A Word file with a written explanation of the above changes
- The updated Monetary Reporting Handbook based on the new ECB guidelines

From the first XBRL reports in 2022 - about the end of January/1st quarter of 2022 - the BSI reports must be submitted with the new taxonomy version 2.0.2.

N.B. Up to and including reference period December/4th quarter 2021 you should report using the current taxonomy v1.0.2.
