These tests are scheduled to start on 17 April 2023. Based on the registration forms provided by the NL participants, DNB has been setting-up counterparties in the test environment. As of 17 April, counterparties will be able to start connectivity testing, based on a schedule provided by DNB. DNB will inform you when you should connect.

## Upcoming events: Readiness reporting

As ECMS will be implemented following a big-bang approach (i.e. simultaneous discontinuation of the current local systems with the go-live of ECMS), close monitoring and cooperation by NCBs and their communities is a key success factor. De Nederlandsche Bank has a monitoring role for the timely readiness of the Dutch community and therefore we

need to provide information to the Eurosystem on the progress of the project on a regular basis. The monitoring is based on a reporting approach with a set of questions defined per milestones.

The 10th cycle of the Readiness reporting is planned for end May, with the following milestones and their respective cut-off dates.
